INCLUSIVE BUSINESS LAUNCH PAD UPDATE



The IBL project aims to help disadvantaged entrepreneurs in microbusinesses grow and enhance their ability to innovate, expand, and export opportunities across the EU and beyond. As part of this, the project partners have recently piloted the Accelerator Business Launch Pad Training. Some partners also held Inclusive Business Launch Pad Circles which aimed to offer a safe and supportive environment to further share, reflect and learn in a smaller group.
